

The Event is run under Motorsport Australia Permit # 824/1011/02.

1. Motorsport Australia Speed Licences

All references to 'Level 2S' Licences within the Supplementary Regulations should be interpretated to mean a 'Motorsport Australia Speed Licence'.

2. Results

Results for timed categories will be published at ½ day intervals.

3. RallySafe

Knowingly turning off or disconnecting your RallySafe device or RallySafe Lite phone application may result in referral to the Clerk of the Course, or their delegate, with penalties up to exclusion.

4. Virtual Chicanes

Penalties for the breach of Virtual Chicane requirements have been updated as follows:

For TSD entrants:

As per the penalty schedule outlined for Competition and Challenge categories in the Supplementary Regulations. Referenced time penalties will be issued in 'penalty points'; not in seconds.

For Spirit Tour entrants:

Failure to meet the requirements of a Virtual Chicane may result in referral to the Clerk of the Course, or their delegate, with penalties up to exclusion.

5. Servicing of Vehicles

No mechanical servicing of vehicles is permitted within the Adelaide Showgrounds complex.

6. Event Schedule

The ½ day training requirement is removed from the Event Programme in Section 1.1 of the Supplementary Regulations. An updated schedule is attached to these Further Regulations as Appendix A.

7. Run-On Vehicles in Classic Sub-Categories

In relation to 'Classic' and 'Modern' sub-categories, vehicles built prior to 1st January 1986 are deemed to be 'Classic'. Vehicles built from 1st January 1986 to present are deemed to be 'Modern'.

In addition to the above, the following 'run-on' considerations are accepted:

Vehicles which were produced after 1st January 1986, which are of a production-run featuring the same engine type and body shape commenced prior to that date, are deemed to maintain 'Classic' categorisation. For example, a 1987 Porsche 944 is eligible for Classic as it was produced with the same body shape and engine type as those produced prior to January 1st 1986.
